
I, Mike Dimick, would like this opportunity to object due to the following reason, attached you will find a copy of the certified letter postmarked November 6, 2021, that contained a check for Wasatch Railcar Contractors in the amount of \$14,200.00. The envelope was rejected and returned to the Shoshoni Post Office December 24, 2021. I had tried on numerous occasions prior to November 3, 2021, to contact John Rimmasch regarding the situation. Phone calls to John Rimmasch were not accepted, and messages were not returned, therefore I sent the attached letter with a check.

In the dismissal it states the reason for dismissing the case being hoppermetals did not honor an agreement to pay. I would like the dismissal revised and not have the blame placed on hoppermetals, as I tried to honor the agreement to the best of my ability. hoppermetals should not be treated as the scapegoat while so many businesses lose out on hundreds of thousands of dollars.

Based on the submitted documents, we would request you review this information and consider my request to not dismiss this case.

This letter is intended to bring closure to the scrap metal transaction between Wasatch Railroad and hoppermetals referenced as "Aluminum Coal Cars".

In the first quarter of 2021, a verbal agreement was made between company presidents to purchase approximately 50-120 rail cars for scrap metal recycling. At that time, the anticipated purchase price for hoppermetals was .225-.245 per pound which was agreed. Materials were to be sold and the profits used first to resolve previous debt owed to hoppermetals, then reimburse Wasatch. In accordance with this rate, hoppermetals purchased a used metal baler to prepare the said materials for mill specifications in the amount of approximately \$250,000. Scrap metal began being received roughly April-May 2021 to the property of hoppermetals.

Unforeseen circumstances revolving around Wasatch Railroad, (industrial accident, EPA/DEQ investigations, chapter 11 bankruptcy) have stressed the dealing with the recycling project. Furthermore, there have been discrepancies in actual weight quantities received in materials to be recycled. Thus, it has been determined the best option is to resolve debt, pay for material received, and move forward on separate paths.


At this time, hoppermetals is willing to acknowledge the receipt of approximately 160,000 pounds of mixed metals. Actual weight will be scaled as the materials are prepared for shipment and any overage will be paid to Wasatch at the for mentioned rate.

We acknowledge 160,000 pounds @ market price of .245 as agreed: \$39,200

We acknowledge previous debt to be in excess of \$25,000 for services rendered.
