I. Job Summary	
The Steam Train Engineer Position is responsible for the daily operation of the Steam Train as well as providing support to the Steam Train Maintenance team as needed.	
II. Summary of Major Duties & Responsibilities	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Operate locomotives and assemble and disassemble trains within railyards• Performs assigned daily, weekly, monthly, semi-annual and annual inspections and preventive maintenance as needed• Inspect locomotive to verify adequate fuel, sand, water, and other supplies before each run, and to identify mechanical and/or safety concerns• Monitor gauges and meters that measure steam pressure, boiler water level, speed, amperage, battery charge, and air pressure in brake lines and in main reservoirs• Inspect locomotives after runs to detect damaged or defective equipment; Identify, plan and correct maintenance and repair issues• Organize and lead the maintenance and repair of all railroad equipment including the train, track, bed system and facilities without supervision• Ensure that scheduled maintenance procedures and regulatory inspections are completed in an efficient and accurate manner• Keep engines, coaches, track perimeter, and maintenance areas clean• Organize and maintain records of work completed; oversee the recordkeeping and maintain accountability of others• Ensure that all assigned ride areas, shops, tools and equipment are clean and visually in compliance with manufacturer's specifications, OSHA requirements, guest expectations, and Silver Dollar City standards• Prepare reports regarding any problems encountered, such as accidents, signaling problems, unscheduled stops, or delays.• Respond to emergency conditions or breakdowns, following applicable safety procedures and rules.• Train personnel to ensure productive use of time and duties are completed properly• Perform grading and excavation of railroad bed and perimeter as necessary• Perform duties in a safe manner in compliance with manufacturer's specifications, company policies & procedures, applicable regulations, and industry standards• Management reserves the right to change and/or add to these duties.	

III. Educational and Experience Requirements

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- High school degree or GED is required
- Must be willing and able to gain steam railroad experience that demonstrates successful execution of similar duties and responsibilities, to include the use of required tools and power equipment
- Must be able to demonstrate a knowledge of the construction, operation, function and regulation of steam locomotives and railroads
- A positive safety record within the industry
- Basic Computer skills beneficial
- Must have or be able to obtain and maintain a Missouri Class E Driver's License or resident state equivalent
- Must have the ability to read/write, comprehend instructions and communicate in English
- Must pass pre-employment drug test and background checks

IV. Personality/Attitude Requirements

- Must project Silver Dollar City's image by being genuinely friendly and caring, and by taking pride in assigned work
- Must genuinely display and live out the core principals of Leading with Love by being: patient, kind, humble, respectful, selfless, forgiving, honest and committed
- Must be willing to support property and divisional leadership in order to create a positive and productive environment
- Must promote and support a "team" work environment by cooperating and helping those who are in need regardless of crew, team, division, or property
- Must be self-motivated and display high standards with quality and quantity of work
- Must be able to prioritize and complete work assignments in a timely matter
- Must maintain strict confidentiality and judgment regarding privileged information
- Must be willing to constantly improve
- Must have a professional appearance with good personal hygiene
- Must adapt to changes easily
- Must tolerate a fast-paced, hectic environment
- Must show appreciation to others
- Must be sensitive to the needs of our Guests and feel empowered to take action to meet their needs within company guidelines
- Must function independently with limited supervision and guidance
- Must be able to consistently be on time and have the ability to work beyond scheduled time off, or report to work on scheduled days off, if necessary
- Must be able to work nights, weekends, and holidays if necessary

V. Essential Functions Necessary To Perform Job Duties

- Ability to hear, see and speak.
- Ability to smile and make eye contact to make a friendly impression when greeting guests, vendors and other employees
- Must have manual dexterity necessary to complete all job duties
- Ability to sit and/or stand for long/short periods
- Ability to get along with other employees to work out problems and resolve conflicts

- Ability to comprehend instructions and retain information
- Ability to be flexible to handle frequent changes in priorities
- Ability to tolerate a year round outdoor environment, with temperatures from 0 to 120 degrees
- Ability to analyze and remember information
- Ability to add, subtract, multiply, and divide in all units of measure, using whole numbers, common fractions, and decimals
- Ability to perform or capability to learn these operations utilizing both Standard Units and the Metric System in weight measurement, volume, and distance
- Ability to tolerate approved exposure levels to various chemicals found in cleaning solvents, adhesives, paints, and lubricants
- Tasks involve the regular, and at times sustained, performance of moderately physically demanding work
 - This typically involves some combination of balancing, stooping, kneeling, and crouching
- Tasks may also involve the lifting, carrying, pushing and/or pulling of objects and materials of moderately heavy weight (up to 50 pounds) and occasionally heavier weight (up to 100 pounds)
- Must possess the mental and physical capabilities necessary to perform the primary job duties, including climbing and working at heights up to and in excess of 150ft. or, crawling and working in confined spaces
- While performing the duties of this job, the individual may be regularly expected to work near moving mechanical parts where there may or may not be a risk of electrical shock; and/or vibration
- Ability to use hand tools and power tools such as electric drill, drill press, side grinder, porta-band, reciprocating saw, electric hoist, chain saw, band saw, jig saw, torque wrench, and impact wrench
- Must possess strong safety sensitivity and ability to work with many different types of mechanical devices
- Ability to perform all other duties as assigned per the physical job description
