SP 3709

PSRM has just acquired an ex-SP GP-9 locomotive. This loco was built in August of 1959, and was among the last order of GP-9s for SP. This loco was one of the first low nose GP-9's built! It was built as SP 5873 and was later re-numbered by SP to 3709, then purchased by the military, and eventually numbered 1401 and made it's way to Camp Pendleton. Now we need your help moving this loco to Campo ASAP. It is estimated we can purchase and move this to Campo for about \$25,000! Just think how good this locomotive MU'd with the SP 3873 would look!
