1. DOOR ENGINES.

Manufactured by the Consolidated Car Heater Company. Here are the model numbers:

- R-5016C3 – We have two of these.
- R-5017C3 – We have one of these.

While the two door engines seem to look identical they are different. The R-5016C3 model was used on the front doors of TCRT's standard streetcars while the other model was used on the rear doors. All of our door engines came from TCRT streetcars.



2. GENERAL ELECTRIC MODEL CP-25 AIR COMPRESSOR.

We have one extra GE CP-25 air compressor. It is currently being refurbished by Lyons Industries of Ebensburg, Pennsylvania.

3. TWO 600-V STREETCAR MOTORS.

We will be sending off a pair of trucks to the shop to be rebuilt this winter. The current motors in the trucks (one per truck) are old (pre-1900), very large and one of them is bad. We could use two 600-v motors of approximately 50-55 hp in size to go into these trucks.

4. STREETCAR TRUCKS.

In lieu of rebuilding a very tired pair of ex-CTA trucks that are currently under TCRT “gate car” No. 1239, our Museum could use a pair of Baldwin No. 5 trucks or the equivalent. The trucks can contain one or two motors per truck of approximately 50-hp in size. We’d like trucks with a 72-inch wheelbase.
